SPEAKERS CORNER:

HAWKS PRAIRIE HEADSTART/ECEAP

Hawks Prairie Head Start/ECEAP is proud to report yet another successful year! We have served over 115 children and families in our area, including 20% of children with disabilities, many of whom were identified by our teachers and referred to the school district and associated health professionals. Each child, regardless of ability, has received individualized educational, emotional health, and family support services. We have also provided a significant amount of training to our educational staff this year, including financial support for many in their pursuit of degrees, and in-house training for those staff getting their Child Development Associate Certificate.

Our center also has four representatives on Policy Council, our program wide parent governing board, one of whom serves as chair-woman. She and another parent were also selected to be Parent Ambassadors to advocate for ECEAP state-wide, including meeting with legislators and testifying before committees about the benefits of our programs and services.

We have completed many projects and programs in each of our classrooms this year. We again provided Raising a Reader bags to each family, which includes a rotating set of books for children to take home and read with their families. All our classrooms also completed the Second Step series around problem solving and conflict resolution, and the Talking about Touching curriculum about personal safety. We have had many successful family nights about topics such as literacy, nutrition and health, fire and personal safety, kindergarten information and registration, and a Health Care Institute sponsored by UCLA and Johnson & Johnson.

We are excited to begin the process for enrolling children for 2010-11! However, it serves as a reminder for all the children we are unable to serve this year. While maintaining full enrollment, our center still has over 90 children and families on our waitlist who will not benefit from a year at Head Start/ECEAP prior to kindergarten. It is so important for us to maintain positive relationships with our community so we can continue to serve the families we do. We thank you for your continued support of our work!

COMMUNITY CORNER

- The TCWRC continues to make donations to the **Other Bank** a high priority. Donations help families who cannot get fundamental house cleaning and hygiene items at the local food bank.
- We are also still collecting **children's books** for the **Headstart** program. Bi-lingual books are needed also.
